

**VILLAGE OF GROSSE TETE MINUTES**  
**REGULAR MEETING**  
**February 12, 2021**

Mayor Michael Chauffe called the February 12, 2021 meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Michael Hughes led the Prayer. The pledge was led by Deisha Chaney and the Meeting began.

**Minutes:** Alderman Marcus Hill made a motion to dispense with the reading and approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting of January 13, 2021. The motion was seconded by Alderman Clint Seneca and passed 3 – 0.

Alderwoman Jeanie David made a motion to dispense with the reading and approve the minutes of the Special Meeting of January 27, 2021. The motion was seconded by Alderman Marcus Hill and passed 3 – 0.

**Finances:** Alderman Clint Seneca made a motion to approve the financial statements of January 31, 2021 as presented. This motion was seconded by Alderwoman Jeanie David and passed 3 – 0.

**Mayor's Report:**

Veterans Memorial Highway – Mayor Chauffe offered a Resolution to rename the portion of Highway 77 that runs through the Village of Grosse Tete Corporate limits to “Veterans Memorial Highway”. After reading the Resolution, a voice vote was taken as follows: YEAS: Clint Seneca, Jeanie David and Marcus Hill, NAYS: None ABSTENTIONS: None

The waterline project is scheduled to be completed before March 31, 2021.

Attorney Robert Marionneaux continues to work on a Servitude Agreement with owners of the Holliday Property where the proposed bypass road will be constructed. An agreement is very near completion.

Mayor Chauffe stated that he has been in contact with Union Pacific Railroad about the blocking of the tracks in Grosse Tete. They assured him that they would work toward a solution to this problem.

The additional parking lot at the walking trail was completed and the paint has started to peel. The contractor will stripe again.

**Amend Agenda** – A motion was made by Alderwoman Jeanie David and seconded by Alderman Marcus Hill to amend the agenda to allow Concerned Citizens of the Village of Grosse Tete to discuss the renovations being made at the Tiger Truck Stop. This motion passed 3-0.

A group of concerned citizens, led by Ms. Althea Littles, came to the Town Hall to get answers about renovations being made at the Tiger Truck Stop. One of the owners of the Truck Stop was in attendance to answer questions from the citizens. At the close of the meeting, all parties were better informed of the process and what to expect in the coming days of this project.
