

**VILLAGE OF GROSSE TETE MINUTES
REGULAR MEETING
July 8, 2021**

Mayor Michael Chauffe called the July 8, 2021 meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Alderman Marcus Hill led the Prayer. The pledge was led by Alderman Clint Seneca and the Meeting began.

Minutes: Alderman Marcus Hill made a motion to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting of June 10, 2021. The motion was seconded by Alderwoman Jeanie David and passed 3 – 0.

Finances: Alderman Clint Seneca made a motion to approve the financial statements of June 30, 2021. This motion was seconded by Alderwoman Jeanie David and passed 3 – 0.

Brian Brumfield: Mr. Brumfield addressed the Mayor and Board of Alderman with concerns of trucks turning around on Sidney Road when missing the turn at the interstate. After discussion, the Village of Grosse Tete will order signs stating “Bridge 500 feet Ahead” in English and Spanish to be placed on Sidney Road South of the Interstate.

Mayor’s Report:

Concerned Citizens: Ms. Julie Wessinger, a resident of Garner Lane addressed Mayor Chauffe and the Board of Alderman with concerns about the Tiger Truck Stop expansion. She stated that there has been a recent incident where a person was sitting on the porch of an elderly resident on Garner Lane. It was suggested that anytime an incident such as that happens to call 911 for a deputy to be dispatched. It was requested that Mayor Chauffe inquire about something to put on the road to keep the dust down. It was also requested that Neighborhood watch signs be placed along Garner Lane.

Police Department – A motion was made by Alderman Clint Seneca and seconded by Alderman Marcus Hill to accept a 2016 Chevrolet Capri from The Iberville Parish Sheriff’s Office as an Act of Donation to the Grosse Tete Police Department. The motion passed 3-0.
