

**VILLAGE OF GROSSE TETE MINUTES  
PUBLIC MEETING  
March 1, 2016**

Representatives of La. Auto Repair held a meeting at the Town Hall on March 1, 2016 at 6:30 p.m.

Alderman Kyle Booksh and Alderwoman Jeanie David attended the public meeting.

Ken Buhler of La. Auto Repair led the meeting. He explained the process of the cleanup and gave a brief overview of the work that had been completed to this point. He also stated that La. Auto Repair would like the Board of Alderman to issue a variance to allow them to plant shrubs to create a green fence around the property because the company could not afford to pay for a wooden fence to be placed around the property.

Members of the audience had questions about the type of plants, placement of plants, upkeep, etc. Alderman Kyle Booksh suggested that a Landscape Architect be involved to guide La. Auto in the selection of plants that would have a better chance of growing for long periods of time in this area.

After more discussion, Alderman Kyle Booksh and Alderwoman Jeanie David stated that they would like to take a survey of all citizens in the area so that all parties involved would have an opportunity to have their voice heard. This item will be further discussed at the March 10, 2016 regular meeting of the Board of Alderman for the Village of Grosse Tete.
