

**VILLAGE OF GROSSE TETE MINUTES
REGULAR MEETING
March 10, 2016**

The Board of Alderman of the Village of Grosse Tete held their regular meeting at the Town Hall in Grosse Tete March 10, 2016 at 6:00 p.m.

Mayor Michael Chauffe called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Phillip Faveroth led the Prayer followed by the pledge led by Alderman Kyle Booksh. Mayor Chauffe called roll and the meeting began.

Property Cleanup Update:

Alderwoman Jeanie David made a motion to have an eight (8) foot solid wood fence along Dewey Drive starting at the Grosse Tete Corporate Limits going in a westerly direction to the adjoining property. A green fence to begin at that point going in a southerly direction to the adjoining property on the south side leaving an area of 6 to 8 feet from the property on the western border for maintenance of the green fence. This motion was seconded by Alderman Marcus Hill and passed 3 – 0.
