

**VILLAGE OF GROSSE TETE MINUTES
REGULAR MEETING
May 13, 2021**

Mayor Michael Chauffe called the May 13, 2021 meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Fire Chief Mike Hughes led the Prayer. The pledge was led by Alderman Clint Seneca and the Meeting began.

Minutes: Alderman Clint Seneca made a motion to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting of April 8, 2021. The motion was seconded by Alderwoman Jeanie David and passed 3 – 0.

Special Meeting Minutes: Alderman Marcus Hill made a motion to approve the minutes of the Special Meeting of April 27, 2021. The motion was seconded by Alderman Clint Seneca and passed 3 – 0.

Finances: Alderwoman Jeanie David made a motion to approve the financial statements of April 30, 2021. This motion was seconded by Alderman Marcus Hill and passed 3 – 0.

Concerned Citizens: Citizens of Garner Lane addressed Mayor and Council with concerns about the Tiger Truck Stop expansion.

P.W. Holliday, Inc.: Alderwoman Jeanie David made a motion authorizing payment for servitude as stated in the agreement with attached map. This motion was seconded by Alderman Clint Seneca and passed 3 – 0.

Railroads and Common Carriers: Ordinance 3 of 2021 was introduced, an ordinance to prohibit blocking railroad crossings. Alderman Clint Seneca made a motion to set a Public Hearing for June 11, 2021, at 5:30p.m. This motion was seconded by Alderwoman Jeanie David and passed 3 – 0.

Ordinance 1 of 2021: Alderman Marcus Hill made a motion to approve an ordinance to designate the office of the Louisiana State Fire Marshall's office to investigate suspected arson and suspicious fires and fire related fatalities in the Village of Grosse Tete. This motion was seconded by Alderman Clint Seneca and passed 3 – 0.

Ordinance 2 of 2021: Alderwoman Jeanie David made a motion to approve an ordinance to amend sewer rates which removes the cap on commercial sewer. This motion was seconded by Alderman Marcus Hill and passed 3 – 0.

Mayor's Report:

Mayor Michael Chauffe gave an update on the Blighted Property and Junk clean up at 76925 Garner Lane.

Alderwoman Jeanie David made a motion to approve a Resolution for Intergovernmental Agreement with WBR Community Development. This motion was seconded by Alderman Marcus Hill and passed 3 – 0.
