

**VILLAGE OF GROSSE TETE MINUTES**  
**REGULAR MEETING**  
**October 8, 2015**

The Board of Alderman of the Village of Grosse Tete held their regular meeting at the Town Hall in Grosse Tete October 8, 2015 at 6:00 p.m.

Mayor Michael Chauffe called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Attorney Larry Bossier led the Prayer. Benny Breaux, a citizen and former alderman led the pledge of allegiance. Mayor Chauffe called roll and the meeting began.
