

VILLAGE OF GROSSE TETE MINUTES
REGULAR MEETING
October 14, 2021

Mayor Michael Chauffe called the October 14, 2021 meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Alderman Marcus Hill led the Prayer. The pledge was led by Chief Tommy Dardenne and the Meeting began.

Minutes: Alderman Clint Seneca made a motion to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting of September 15, 2021. The motion was seconded by Alderman Marcus Hill and passed 3 – 0.

Finances: Alderman Marcus Hill made a motion to approve the financial statements of September 30, 2021. This motion was seconded by Alderwoman Jeanie David and passed 3 – 0.

Mayor's Report:

- Parish President Mitchell Ourso came out to look at a drainage project that the Village of Grosse Tete is partnering with the Parish to assist with drainage issues in our community. He also inspected the Boat Ramp and Pier at the ramp that needed some repairs to be completed and will have those necessary repairs made.
- Mayor has signed a Cooperative Endeavor Agreement for funding for the Highway 77 By-Pass road project.
- Brad Guerin of Fusion Architects came out to look at the Town Hall and give an estimate on cost to upgrade our Town Hall.
